College Assemblies

Rationale

St Maroun's College believes that it is important for the College to regularly come together in a corporate gathering. This helps to foster a sense of pride, belonging and community, allows us to celebrate student and staff successes, provides leadership opportunities for students and allows important information to be communicated to the student body. In the case of the Primary department assemblies are also used to promote corporate spiritual growth.

Procedure

Secondary

The Secondary College assemble together in the quadrangle every Tuesday morning from 8:30am.

If the weather is unsuitable, then the assembly is moved to the covered Canteen area.

Secondary Assemblies are led by the student leaders and are opened with prayer. Rolls are to be marked in this time together.

All staff are expected to attend College Assemblies.

Sport

A secondary Sports assembly is conducted by the Sports Coordinator each Tuesday at the end of lunch prior to students being dismissed to their allocated sport.

Supervising teachers are expected to attend this Assembly.

Primary

The Primary College assembles each morning to be dismissed to their classes. However Monday and Thursday are the days that the Primary Department allocate for formal Assemblies. Staff are rostered on to conduct these assemblies and they are always commenced with prayer. Parents are encouraged to attend these assemblies.

Each Monday the National Anthem is sung, student birthdays are celebrated and organisational announcements are made.

The Thursday assembly is a time where student success is celebrated through the presentation of Merit Awards, Principal Awards, Certificates of recognition from competitions and performances of musical and dance items are displayed. Student leaders assist in the conduct of these special assemblies.
